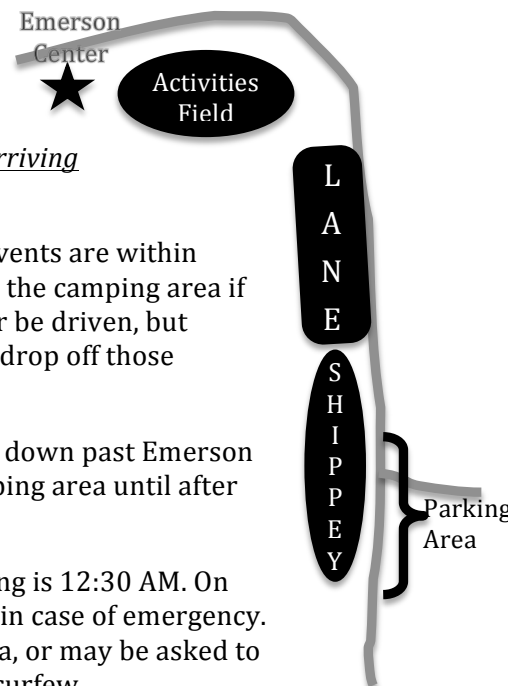

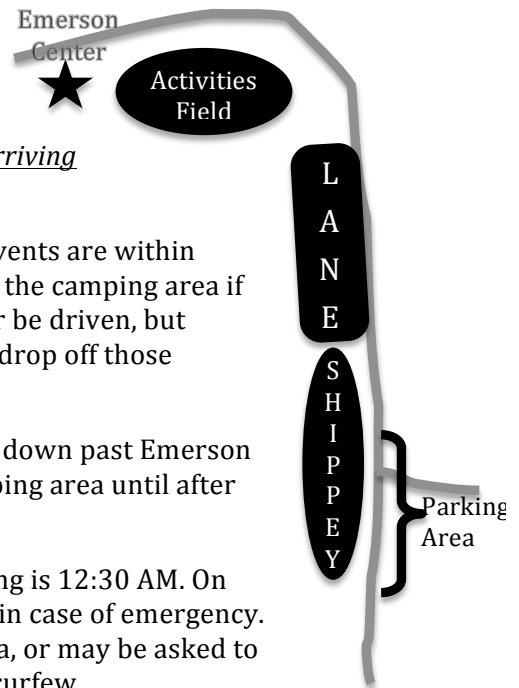

- 1. The speed limit is 15. Don't speed, its that simple.**
- 2. After unloading your car at the camping area please move it to the parking area.** In order to make space in the camping area (Lane) for those arriving after you, please move your car down the road to the middle of the next field (Shippey). Each unit may keep a car or two at Lane, *but please do what you can to clear space for those arriving after you.* If you are camping in Shippey, you may leave your car there.
- 3. There is no driving around the Fall Fun Rally to get to events.** All events are within walking distance. *Exceptions:* You may drive to Horseback Rides from the camping area if you have tickets. Those that have a mobility disability may also drive or be driven, but there is limited parking at all of the activity locations. You may have to drop off those needing transportation and walk from the nearest parking spots.
- 4. If you are leaving during the day on Saturday,** please move your car down past Emerson Center before 8 AM. Cars may not be allowed to drive back to the camping area until after program ceases at 5 PM. Please plan accordingly.
- 5. There should be no driving after curfew.** Curfew on Saturday Morning is 12:30 AM. On Sunday Morning it is 1:00 AM. After this time, please no driving except in case of emergency. Those violating this rule may not be allowed back into the camping area, or may be asked to leave the event. Those leaving Beaumont should plan to return before curfew.
- Unit leaders are responsible for their youths' driving at the event. **Please monitor their compliance with these rules.** Many adult leaders will ask for keys from the youth once they have arrive.
