THINGS TO KNOW

- There are bathrooms in the Emerson Center and at the pool.
- The Emerson center will be open during program on Friday and from 7a - Midnight on Sat. and 7a- Noon on Sun. Showers are available at the pool (<18) and in the Emerson Center (18+). The Showers in the Emerson Center are located in the bathrooms in the basement.
- Curfew is 12:30 AM on Friday Night and 1:00 AM on Saturday Night. Please be on your campsite and quiet so that you do not disturb others at this time. Please be respectful of your neighbors.
- There is no central medical staff for this event. First Aid is the responsibility of the unit leader. Of course in an emergency, please notify the event staff, especially if needing to leave the event.
- There is no driving around the Fall Fun Rally to get to events. All events are within walking distance. Exceptions: You may drive to horseback rides from the camping area if you have signed up. Those that have a mobility issue may also drive or be driven, but there is limited parking at all activity locations. You may have to drop off those needing transportation and walk from the nearest parking spots. Please limit your driving coming and going from the event or for those that cannot walk distances. The large parking lot at Emerson Center will be reserved for activities on Saturday. Parking will be extremely constrained in front of the Emerson Center.
- Please refer to all other parking rules on the parking pass that you were issued when entering the Fall Fun Rally.
- Ground fires are permitted. Please ensure that your fire is safe. Only dead fallen wood may be burned or cut. Do not cut down any standing trees. Please remove all pieces of wood at the end of the event so that the rangers can mow.
- SCUBA: Be A Diver Requires a waiver to participate. Those under 18 require a parent or guardian signature.
- As always, fireworks, non-prescription drugs, alcohol, and acts of a sexual nature are not allowed and will result in your being asked to leave the event.
- Adults are responsible for your units' youth at all times. Please ensure that your youth are acting responsibly, including at the dance and at the campsite.
- Units eating in the Emerson Center are asked to clean their own tables and wipe them down after eating. We eat in shifts, so your cooperation in moving through is appreciated.
- All participants, adult or youth, must wear a wristband. Those not wearing their wristbands will be denied participation in any and all activities.

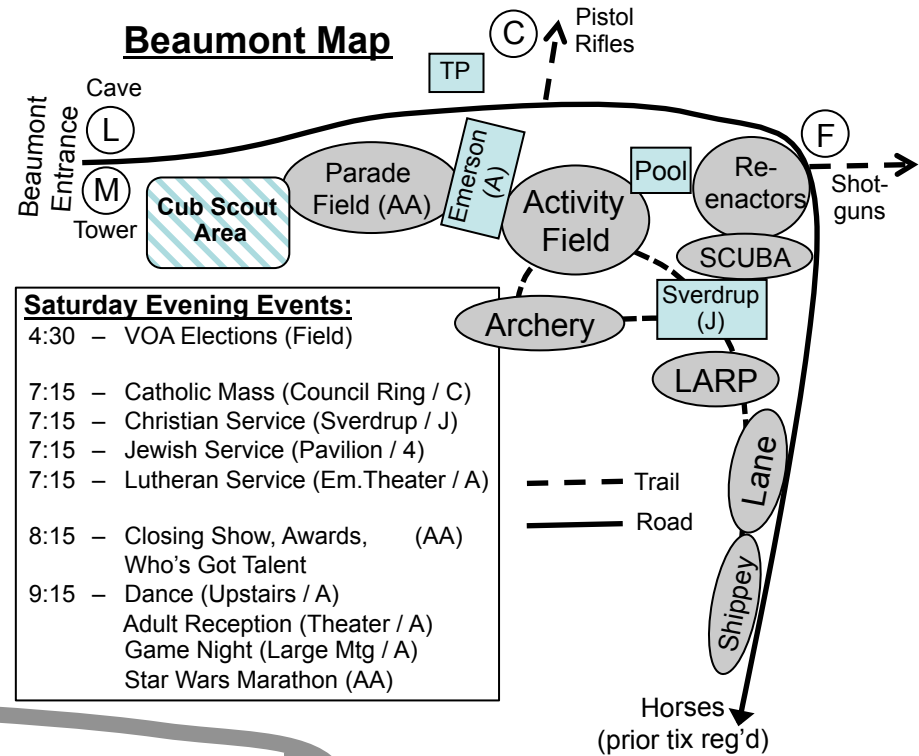


Fall Fun Rally Event Map
