

# Wilderness First Aid Challenge

## Who Can Compete?

- Any Unit with a team of at least 4
- All Scouts ages 14-20 that form a team
- Adult Advisors / Leaders are not allowed as part of their Unit's team

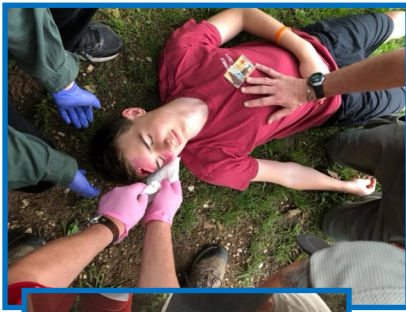
## How Do We Sign Up?

- To sign up stop by the Nature Lodge and choose a time slot for your team or **Sign Up at Check In**
- Each team will have the same amount of time to compete in the challenge (30 minute slots)

## How Long Can We Compete?

- There are two shifts to choose a time slot from; 09:00a-12:00p and 1:00 - 4:00p on Saturday
- Each Team can only compete once
- Scouts can be members of a maximum of 2 different teams

## Is Your Team Ready?



Can your team meet the challenge of Wilderness First Aid? Here are just some of the components:

- Role Players moulaged to look like they have real injuries
- Role Players who are experienced and correctly display symptoms
- First aid skills from simple to complex
- Correct usage of supplies and gear
- Multi-person role play scenarios

### What do we need to bring & plan for?

Your team can bring any supplies that they can carry during their challenge. You must be able to carry it in a pack. We will also supply first aid gear and materials (and a quick review on how to use it prior to your team's challenge) onsite. Your team must bring their own gear bag (think backpacks) to carry any first aid supplies or gear that your want to use. There will be a trained staff to facilitate that challenge and ensure the safety of all participants and role players. Adults are welcome to attend the challenge to take pictures of their team and watch them perform, however adults are NOT allowed to participate or instruct their teams. Youth are NOT allowed to take pictures during any of the team challenges.

**WHEN:**

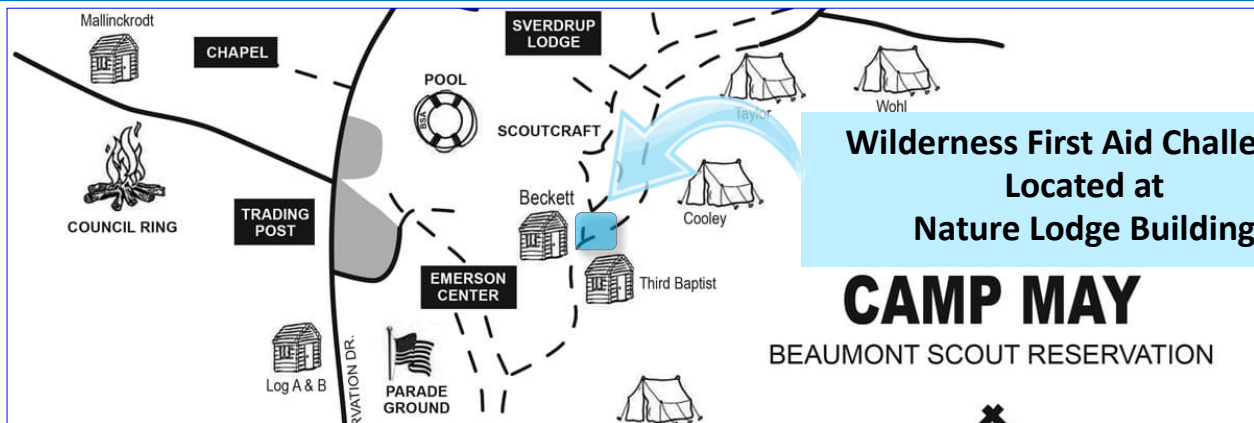
**First Shift: Saturday 9:00am - 12:00pm**  
**Second Shift: Saturday 1:00pm - 4:00pm**

**WHERE:**

Home Base is located at the **Nature Lodge**, Scenarios will take place in a secured area close to Beckett. Please do not enter the Scenario Area unless you are competing.

**HOW:**

**PRE-REGISTER ONLINE, REGISTER AT CHECK IN on Friday Night** or come by the Nature Lodge and sign up on Saturday morning to secure your time slot. Scenarios will be set up in 30 minute rotation. You should plan on arriving 5-10 minutes before your scheduled scenario to prepare. If you choose Option 2 (see below) for your team, please arrive at the scheduled time as planned by Squad when you sign up. We ask that all teams choose your Option (1,2, or 3) and your Skill Level (see below) early. **Please do not call 911 just because you hearing screaming. Check it out first. :)**



**What To Expect:**

Scenarios range across three categories and each Team can choose accordingly. The more challenging the category, the more points you can earn for your Team. There will be a **Beginner level scenario, Intermediate level scenario, and Advanced level scenario** to choose from. Your team could be “rescuing” one or multiple subjects depending on your Team’s choice of scenario. All subjects are live role players. Expect the possibility of getting on the ground or getting dirty.

**How To Score Your Best:**

**Each Team can choose from the levels listed above and from the following three options to do their best while competing:**

- ⇒ **Option 1: Squad Team Member**—a team may choose this option if they would like to select a Squad member to become a part of their team during the competition scenario. If this option is chosen, the Squad member will become a part of the team and can be asked questions and can participate with the team as they conquer their scenario. This option has a low scoring base.
- ⇒ **Option 2: Skills Orientation**—a team may choose this option if they feel they need a refresher in some first aid skills to be able to score better during their competition scenario. With this option, a team may choose to spend 15 minutes asking for reviews on skills of their choice and Squad members will instruct them and let them practice skills. This choice has an intermediate scoring base. **You must arrive 15 minutes early for this option.**
- ⇒ **Option 3: Independent Team**—a team may choose this option if they feel that their team is well equipped and experienced and can function well without outside assistance. A team that chooses this option will not receive assistance either in training or in skills before or during the competition scenario. The team is “on their own”. This choice has a high scoring base.

*All teams will be scored according to the same criteria regardless of their Option Choice. However, there will be a point increase or decrease applied to the overall score according to the option chosen. Deductions can be applied to the overall score if a team incurs a violation (see violation sheet when checking in). Squad will be present during ALL competition scenarios for safety and can pause the scenario at any time to insure the team’s safety as well as the role players’ safety. Squad has the final say when running scenarios to ensure a fun and safe competition for everyone.*
